Senate Repeals Law of Gravity

We've been led, misled, entertained and mentally detained by the recent impeachment charade. Anticipating only a short intermission between Acts II and III, let's consider a few points and put a wrap to this story. The Senate had only one simple job, i.e., abide by their oath of office, consider the evidence as presented by the House, and act in conformance with Constitutional provisions. They did not.

The Senate's fail to convict was not, we understand, because most considered him innocent of the crimes of which he was charged. It was simply that the alleged felonies were somehow insufficient to remove him from office. Yet the gravity of such crimes, at least up until this infamous incident, were more than sufficient to remove from office both those of equal and lesser political stature. If we assume the Senate's work included a legitimate search for the truth intended to meet the letter of the Constitution, the outcome was an act which defies not only the overwhelming evidence but logic itself. That is, we repeat, if we assume the Senate and the public indeed share the same objectives. They don't.

The impeachment hearings found the public easily satiated with diversions of sleazy sex. The ominous implications of Mr. Clinton's character were well camouflaged by the media. Despite the seriousness of Mr. Clinton's offenses to the office and the nation we should not have been amazed that the Senate so easily and selectively repealed the law of judicial gravity. The surprise is that these proud and arrogant men would do so in full public view, for the most specious reasons, and in such a way as to confirm the reality that they do not consider themselves or the Executive bound by Constitutional obligations.

What is clear is that the criminal acts of the president were compounded by the Senate who assumed the unconstitutional authority to dismiss charges on the basis of political expediency. That, of course, is the nature of socialism. It is a philosophy that holds no one accountable for their acts. It is a system in which the state dictates law by political whim.

The American public got the form of a trial, but not the substance. They looked for justice, but saw only partisanship. They trusted those sitting in judgment would act in sincerity, but were mocked by lack of intellectual and factual honesty. Where indeed, was the moral code inherent in the Constitution applied which demands integrity in public employees? But, while being misled and entertained we became witness to the nature of the proposed globalist NWO empire. As the nation slept many watched as we wagged the dog, bombed foreign lands, intimidated foreign leaders for global and commercial causes, broke faith with other governments, swept dirty political laundry under the carpet, and in secret agreement gave the American public the "raspberry".

Among the low points of the "trial" we did get a few good chuckles. New North Carolina senator, Mr. Jim (the Groupie) Edwards opined that since there was "disagreement" among senators on the impeachment issue, the presence of indecision alone was sufficient justification in and of itself to simply avoid independent thought. In this and a thousand other ways we perceive the stage being set in America for the same.

Perhaps we should also view these military adventures as a sign of desperation. The cycles of history are certainly well known and the American/UN empire is on shaky ground indeed. The world economy is collapsing under an unstable national and world debt pyramid (reported at around \$40 and \$125 trillion respectively). The associated political instabilities are only aggravated with pending Y2K uncertainties. How can America preserve its political and military dominance and still hope to find its way out of this financial morass of fiat debt without the stimulating affect of WAR?

SUBMISSION TO AUTHORITY

The Founders & Civil Disobedience

A letter received from “William ..., a brother patriot”, requested comment on an important issue, Biblical justification for civil disobedience. A brief answer might serve. But the question demands a proper answer because this issue touches the heart of religious conviction, social responsibility and the role of the militia. His letter reads as follows:

“The 1st and 2nd verse of the 13th chapter of Romans makes a “blanket” statement that we are to submit to governing authorities.

It reads in the NIV. ‘(1) Everyone must submit himself to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God established. The authorities that exist have been established by God. (2) Consequently, he who rebels against the authority is rebelling against what God has instituted, and those who do so will bring judgment on themselves.’

I would like to hear your thoughts on this issue in regards to how the Christian founders justified what seems to be contrary to God’s word, rebelling and overthrowing against established authority.

Maybe this could be addressed in the CFP. I have found that many Christians use this part of the Bible to justify laying down liberty.”

CFP Response To “Biblical Justification”:

Some look to the scriptures for truth and understanding. Some cling to passages which support a desired belief. The fearful, the weak, and the improvident also search, for comfort, consolation, or simply social acceptance. Where truth cannot be avoided, many seek justification or pardon from having to live up to the responsibilities inherent in Christianity. Nothing comes without price, and liberty is the price for abdicated responsibility. The truth makes us uneasy, as it should. As you shall see, it also makes us free.

The ministers of the revolutionary period, like the Founding Fathers, were first and foremost well educated men, in language, history, philosophy, and particularly the Bible. They did not need to invent justification for civil disobedience, they found it in scripture.

In the King James Version we get a better sense of what the Puritans and their Protestant descendants read and believed. They considered the whole text, and the context in which it was written.

“Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is not power but of God: the powers that be are ordained of God. Whosoever therefore resisteth the power, resisteth the ordinance of God: and they that resist shall receive to themselves damnation. For rulers are

not a terror to good works, but to the evil. Wilt thou then not be afraid of the power? do that which is good. But if thou do that which is evil, be afraid; for he beareth not the sword in vain: for he is the minister of God, a revenger to execute wrath upon him that doeth evil. Wherefore ye must need be subject, not only for wrath, but also for conscience sake. For this cause pay ye tribute also: for they are God's minister, attending continually upon this very thing." Romans 13: 1-6, KJV

This scripture speaks specifically of obedience only to rulers and ministers who abide by God's law. Such rulers, we read, act under the authority of God, and as agents of good they have the authority to wield the "sword" against those who do evil. The Founders and the clergy of the day understood that since all authority is derived from God, civil authorities are also subject to the "higher powers". Therefore, those subject to civil authority have a duty to obey them in all righteous things.

The apostle Paul who wrote the Epistle to the Romans, spent quite a bit of time avoiding or enduring imprisonment in Roman jails. The nature of his offense, of course, was civil disobedience. He preached of an authority "higher" than the Roman emperor. Evidently, he had no difficulty determining which authority would command his obedience.

The early American clergy, consistent with Paul's teaching, did not believe in unconditional obedience to civil authority. God, they understood, does not condone lawlessness. Therefore, they reasoned, a ruler who is God's minister retains lawful authority only as long as he observes God's laws. Conversely, subjects condone the lawlessness of civil authorities by obedience to unjust laws. Those that claim obedience to lawless authorities is required by God are willingly uniting with them in rebellion against God.

Reflecting on the duty of kings, early Protestant ministers recognized that the Bible contained clear guidelines for both the choosing of rulers and the obligations and duties of rulers who lawfully exercise their authority:

"Thou shalt in any wise set him king over thee, whom the Lord thy God shall choose: one from among thy brethern shalt thou set king over thee: thou mayest not set a stranger over thee, which is not thy brother. ... Neither shall he multiply wives to himself, that his heart turn not away: neither shall he greatly multiply to himself silver and gold. And it shall be, when he sitteth upon the throne of his kingdom, that he shall write him a copy of this law in a book out of that which is before the priests and Levites: And it shall be with him, and he shall read therein all the days of his life: that he may learn to fear the Lord his God, to keep all the words of the law and these statutes, to do them: That this heart be not lifted up above his brethren, and that he turn not aside from the commandment, to the right hand, or to the left: to the end that he may prolong his days in his kingdom, he, and his children, in the midst of Israel." Deuteronomy 17: 15-20, KJV

Revolutionary era clergy believed, therefore, that civil authorities, including magistrates and those sent to enforce civil law, have no permission to do anything contrary to God's law. The legitimacy of their acts is defined by their conformity to that law. Consider, for example:

"It is an abomination to kings to commit wickedness: for the throne is established by righteousness." Proverbs 16:12, KJV

These early ministers also recognized that the Bible defines two types of authority. That is, lawful authority practiced by righteous rulers consistent with God's law, and that of civil authorities which He may allow to implement unjust laws for reminding His people of their obligations. Yet, even God did not recognize these civil authorities as lawful rulers:

“They have set up kings, but not by me: they have made princes, and I knew it not;”
Hosea 8:4, KJV

Rev. Sedlack (author of “The Black Regiment”), provides a quote from a revolutionary era sermon by Rev. Samuel West which [reflecting philosopher John Locke] illustrates these convictions:

“If magistrates are ministers of God only because the law of God points out the necessity of such an institution for the good of mankind, it follows, that whenever they pursue measures directly destructive of the public good they cease being God's ministers, they forfeit their right to obedience from the subject, they become the pests of society, and the community is under the strongest obligation of duty both to God and to its own members, to resist and oppose them, which will be so far from resisting the ordinance of God that it will be strictly obeying his commands.”

This position is reinforced in an article (Defensive Arms Vindicated) attributed to Captain Stephen Case of the Ulster County militia, written in 1779 which reflects the perspective of the citizen soldier:

“I do allow that rebellion against lawful magistrates is a most damnable sin, I do not allow that the ordinance of magistracy, which is of God., is not to be resisted; no, not so much as by disobedience or non-obedience; nay, not so much as mentally, by cursing in the heart, Eccles. x.20. But a person clothed therewith, abusing his power, may be so far resisted; but tyrants, or magistrates turning tyrants, are not God's ordinances; and there is no hazard of damnation for refusing to obey their unjust commands; but rather, the hazard of that is in walking willingly after the commandment, when the statutes of Omri are kept; so that what is objected from Eccles. viii. 2. 4. I counsel thee to keep the king's commandments, etc. is to be understood only of the lawful commands of lawful things.”

Jacob Cushing, preached a sermon at Lexington, Massachusetts in April, 1778, entitled Divine Judgments Upon Tyrants: And Compassion To The Oppressed. In it he reflects on the concept of responsibility of the governed to resist tyranny. More importantly, he draws the implication from just wars described in scriptures [Judges 19:20; Exodus 17:9, et al.] to justify, even demand, the use of force where necessary to compel compliance with lawful laws. He observes:

“If this war be just and necessary on our part, as past all doubt it is, then we are engaged in the work of the Lord, which obliges us (under God mighty in battle) to use our “swords as instruments of righteousness, and calls us to the shocking, but necessary, important duty of shedding human blood”; not only in defense of our property, life and religion, but in obedience to him who hath said, “Cursed be he that keepeth back his sword from blood.” [Jeremiah 48:10]

It is interesting to note [from Sedlak, The Black Regiment] that British sympathizer Peter Oliver first used the name “Black Regiment” to refer to the American clergy. He observed that they were at the very heart of the dissent which prompted the war for American independence. These men provided not only the “conviction and wisdom” but provided the moral basis, the tenacity, and in

many cases the actual military leadership without which the war may not have been won. Reverend Sedlak observed that “so impressive was the pulpit in providing leadership, that the Sons of Liberty often organized their followers in the church building and through church officers.”

Despite their apparent advocacy of Christian militancy, the cause of peace and the message of the Gospel was not neglected by the clergy. However, Biblical references to brotherhood, ministering, charity, and love, were balanced by a consideration of Christian duty and responsibility. Indeed, by taking the Biblical example literally they understood they had a personal and collective obligation to fulfill their Christian commission. To do otherwise would be to refute God’s commission to His people to resist evil.

Nor were the clergy intimidated by passages which admonished Christians to “turn the other cheek” (Matthew 5:39), or which forbids returning evil for evil (Romans 12:17), or which cautions believers not to “take up the sword” for unlawful purposes (Luke 22:36; Matthew 26:52). These admonitions, they understood, were intended to condemn private revenge or inappropriate use of violence for personal satisfaction.

Eidsmoe (*Christianity And The Constitution*, 1987) references a letter from John Jay (youngest delegate to the Continental Congress of 1774 from New York) to John Murry, a Quaker, in which he discusses the issue of war and pacifism. He notes that Jay “first noted that the Bible places certain “institutions” of regulations on war; and if the Bible regulates war, it must approve war if conducted according to these regulations.” From cites from Jay’s letter:

“The gospel appears to me to consider the servants of Christ as having two capacities or character, with correspondent duties to sustain and fulfill.

Being subjects of his spiritual kingdom, they are bound in that capacity to fight, pursuant to his orders, with spiritual weapons, and against his and their spiritual enemies.

Being also subjects and partakers in the rights and interests of a temporal or worldly state or kingdom, they are in that capacity bound, wherever lawfully required, to fight with weapons in just and necessary war, against the worldly enemies of that state or kingdom.”

Further, these examples did not forbid lawful defense or the use of arms for other lawful purposes. Tory minister John Fletcher expressed this view eloquently and in detail in an address, *The Bible And The Sword*, given in England in 1776:

“If indeed all men were Christians, and every nominal Christian was led by the spirit of Christ, there would be absolutely no need of the sword; for there would be nothing but justice, truth, and love in the world. But reason dictates, that, so long as the wicked shall use the sword in support of vice, the righteous, who are in power, must use it in self defense of virtue. ... this righteous lion of the tribe of Judah, will never suffer Satan and his servants so to bear the sword, as to engross the use of it. This would be letting them have the kingdom, the power, and the glory, without control.”

From the foregoing, it is clear that political thinking in colonial America was shaped by firm religious beliefs. These beliefs recognized the balance between the message of peace and brotherhood of the Gospel, and Christian duty under God’s law to resist unlawful acts and abusive civil authorities, where necessary, through lawful use of arms.

It is important to recognize that these religious convictions did not include “rebellious and overthrowing against established authority.” We reflect that for years preceding the war for American independence colonists used every means available to petition King George and the governors of the colonies for redress of grievances arguing, in part, that they were entitled to all the “rights of Englishmen”. To this end they exercised forbearance to “endure grief, suffering wrongfully” [1 Peter 2:19] while seeking redress. Further, even when well into the military conflict, many retained hope and aspired to reconcile their differences with England. Their objective even then was not to seek independence but to compel a return to lawful government and adherence to the English “common law” rights of the colonists.

Due to their inability to encourage reform in civil government, and finding themselves increasingly unable to obey the dictates of a Biblically errant ruler, faithful obedience to a “higher authority” consistent with Paul’s epistle to the Romans led the Founders to abide by conscience to pursue a new form of government. In doing so they gave their posterity a remarkable new political system founded on Biblical law. This system incorporated two unique concepts: a reliance on “higher powers” which provided a basis in civil law for limited government, and the concept of “unalienable”, or God-given rights which were to be guaranteed by government and therefore, never subject to corruption by civil authorities.

These concepts are at the heart the Declaration of Independence. This document becomes more remarkable with each reading as we come to realize that our “equality” before the law, our “unalienable” rights, and our status of sovereign citizens absolutely depends on our belief in an authority “higher” than civil authority. This biblical “reference” is the basis for the establishment of absolute standards in law. It is the essential ingredient which guarantees our freedom..

Simply put, without God there can be no unalienable rights and no true freedom; with God there can be no accommodation with a secular system of governance which is not restrained to good works and lawful administration by a “higher authority”.

The truth has made us free. The clergy, the Founding Fathers, and early American patriots had the absolute conviction that their cause was just and lawful, and the courage to pursue their grievances to resolution. But now, like then, it is this intransigent faith in this “higher power” which makes patriotic Americans “dangerous” to those who are undermining the Constitution in an attempt to replace our form of government with a secular totalitarian socialist form of global governance.

This limited constitutional republic will survive so long as we understand the profound implications of the power inherent in a code of law in which citizens and government alike remain subject to “higher authority”. It will survive so long as we understand our duty to obey civil authorities only in lawful matters. It will survive so long as it’s citizens are willing to defend it.

“There are many ways of fighting. Many a man or woman has waged a good war for truth, honor, and freedom, who did not shed blood in the process. Beware of those who would use violence, too often it is the violence they want and neither truth nor freedom.” Louis L’Amour, The Walking Drum.

Deep in the heart of rural, conservative North Carolina, the Surry County Community College, assisted by the offices of the State Fire Marshall and the North Carolina Division of Emergency Management sponsored an "anti-terrorist" training program. The exercises were held in Mt. Airy during the week of March 1st. As reported by The Mount Airy News: "The exercise is the first of its kind in the state, according to Charles Smith, SCC coordinator of emergency services, and state leaders have been eager to observe and participate in the project."

Among the various emergency response groups represented in the exercises were the Surry County Sheriff's Department and Emergency Medical Service, the Mt. Airy Police Department and the NC Highway Patrol. Also present were other "non-local" agencies which local media declined to identify, but which local residents reported as the BATF and FBI.

Along with general search and rescue type emergencies were simulated "terrorist" exercises involving scenarios which included a car bomb attack, a bank robbery with hostages, and an "attack" on a government complex..

Local residents, although apparently well aware of the exercises, were reluctant to discuss the event. One unconfirmed report noted that at one point the "bad guys" were allegedly members of a fictional organization called the "Citizen Patriots of America".

While locally sponsored, the exercise was reminiscent of recently held military assault type exercises in Texas, California and Alabama. In one Texas exercise [i.e. operation "Last Dance"] one of the objectives was to rescue hostages and "confiscate weapons" from a group of dissident Americans. Here, like in many similar exercises, we see the intentional effort to vilify patriotic Americans by association. It is a thread so pervasive that it's persistence clearly telegraphs intent.

Our many veteran readers might give some thought to this nationwide pattern of exercises. In doing so we reflect that not so long ago Uncle Sam sought out and actively recruited and trained patriotic Americans to destroy enemies of the Union. Today we find Uncle Sam training people to vilify and destroy patriotic citizens as enemies of the State. Do you think there's a message for us somewhere in all this? Evidently, the few citizens of Mt. Airy we talked to did.

BASIC FIRST AID PRIMER

This article was composed at the request of a reader and with the intention of providing some general first aid knowledge to those unacquainted with basic techniques, or who may be called upon to respond to an emergency situation with very limited resources. Readers should note that this general information is not a substitute for formal medical training which can and should be obtained through courses taught by competent medical personnel.

This material does not address specific blood borne pathogen and other medical precautions which should be observed by first aid providers. Therefore, anyone seriously considering the need to provide such emergency medical assistance should attend one or more first aid programs available from the Red Cross and similar groups.

The Basics of First Aid

Through proper First Aid, you can save yourself and others. You may be able to save a life, prevent permanent disability, and reduce periods of hospitalization. Casualty evaluation is the first step in any first aid procedure. Don't panic; keep the casualty calm. Let them know you are going to help them and that they will be okay.

The ABC's of First Aid

You must carefully evaluate casualties to determine the required first aid. Do this evaluation and the required actions in the right order to find the most serious condition first.

- A. Check the airway. Make sure the casualty is breathing. Lack of oxygen because of a blocked airway or inadequate breathing will lead to brain damage or death in only a few minutes.
- B. Check for bleeding. Stop the bleeding. Without blood, oxygen cannot get to the body parts and they will start to die.
- C. Control shock. Prevent or treat shock. Preventing shock generally increases the casualty's chances of survival. Rapid treatment of shock is essential. Shock can cause death even when the injury usually would not be fatal.
- D. Dress and bandage the wound to avoid infection. The wound healing properly depends a great deal on how well the wound was dressed to begin with.

How To Evaluate A Casualty

When you find someone unconscious or injured, you must accurately evaluate the casualty to determine what to do. Your actions will treat the injury or illness and prevent further injury or death. You should seek Medical support ASAP, but do not stop treatment.

After giving first aid treatment, continue to monitor the casualty for conditions which may require further treatment or other life saving actions. Such actions include maintaining the airway, control of bleeding, and treatment for shock. You should continue to monitor the casualty until relieved by medical personnel.

Check the casualty for a response. Gently shake or tap them and calmly ask, "Are you okay?" if the casualty does not respond go to step two. If the casualty is conscious but is choking perform chest thrusts. If the casualty responds, continue evaluation. Ask where they feel different than usual. Ask, "Where do you feel pain?" or "where do you have no feeling?" if there is no feeling in some part of the body suspect a broken back or neck. DO NOT move the casualty unless to save their life. Movement may cause paralysis or death.

Check the airway. If the casualty is breathing go to step three. If the casualty is not breathing, stop the evaluation and begin treatment by opening the airway and performing rescue breathing. Check for pulse. If a pulse is present and the casualty is breathing go to step four. If a pulse is present, but the casualty is still not breathing, start rescue breathing. If pulse is not present, start CPR. When the casualty is breathing and has a pulse, then go to step four.

Check for bleeding. Look for spurts of blood or blood soaked clothes. Also check for both entry and exit wounds. If the casualty is bleeding from an open wound, stop the evaluation and begin treatment.

Control shock. If you see signs or symptoms of shock, stop the evaluation and begin treatment immediately. When you have completed the treatments for shock, go to step six.

Check for neck or back injuries. Immobilize any casualty you suspect has a neck or back injury.

Check the casualty for open and closed fractures. If you suspect or find a fracture. Stop the evaluation and begin treatment.

Check for possible head injury. If you suspect a head injury, continue to watch for signs which would require rescue breathing, CPR, control of bleeding, or treatment for shock, get medical help.

Check for burns. Look carefully for reddened, blistered, or charred skin. Also. Check for singed clothing. If you find burns, stop the evaluation and begin treatment.

Self Aid

Panic is your worst enemy. Remain calm talk to yourself, and think things through. Decide as quickly and sensibly as possible what is wrong. Can you get help? Where is the nearest person? Where is the nearest aid station? Can you attract attention by yelling, firing a weapon, or building a fire? Get any bleeding stopped, and you will have time for remaining problems. If you have a major medical emergency, don't lose your head, remain calm, lie down and make yourself comfortable, Conserve your energy and don't tire yourself out.

CPR (The Short Version)

- * Determine unresponsiveness, gently shake and shout are you OK. Call 911 (if available)
- * Position on back supporting head and neck during roll over.
- * Open airway, tilt head back and lift chin. Position your ear over mouth to check for breathing or breath on your cheek, or for chest movement.
- * Begin rescue breaths, pinch nostrils closed and seal mouth to mouth and give two full rescue breaths 1 to 1-1/2 seconds each. Observe chest rise. Allow lung deflation between breaths.
- * If rescue breath is not reaching lungs finger sweep mouth for obstruction, reposition head and repeat rescue breaths.
- * Check for pulse next to windpipe. If pulse is detected continue rescue breaths (one breath each five seconds for an adult). If no pulse Begin chest compressions, locate tip of breastbone.
- * Place heel of the hand closest to the head 1" above sternum tip and place second hand over top of the first hand.
- * Depress lower half of sternum straight down 1-1/2 to 2" – 15 compressions in 10 seconds then 2 rescue breaths. Continue until help arrives.

Bleeding

Stop the bleeding and protect the wound. Examine the casualty and determine if there is more than one wound. The exit wound is usually larger than an entry wound. Cut or tear the clothing to expose the wound except in an NBC environment. If there is clothing or debris stuck in the wound, leave it alone do not touch the wound.

Field Dressing

Use a field dressing: 1. Grasp the tails with both hands. 2. Pull the dressing open with the bandage against the wound. 3. Place the dressing directly over the wound. 4. Wrap the dressing tails in the opposite direction around the injured part. 5. Tie the tails into a knot over the site of the bleeding. Tie firmly to prevent slipping but loose enough to insert a finger between the knot and dressing. If the dressing is too loose, it will not control the bleeding nor protect the wound. If it is too tight, it will cut off the blood supply to the far end of the arm or leg.

Direct Pressure/ Pressure Dressings

If bleeding continues after applying a field dressing, use direct pressure. Place your hand on the dressing and exert firm pressure for 5 to 10 minutes. 2. While exerting firm pressure, elevate the injured limb 2 to 4 inches above the heart. Splint the limb before elevating if needed.

Pressure dressings aid in blood clotting and compress the open blood vessel. If bleeding continues after the application of a field dressing, direct manual pressure, and elevation apply a pressure dressing. To do so place a padding of any clean, bulky material on top of the field dressing, directly over the wound. A second field dressing may be used. DO NOT remove the first dressing. 2. Place an improvised dressing over the padding. 3. Wrap the ends tightly around the injured limb, covering the field dressing. 4. Tie the ends together in a knot make sure the knot tight enough so that only the tip of one finger will fit between the dressing and the knot. DO NOT tie so tightly as to cause a tourniquet like effect. 5. Apply up to three pressure dressings. If bleeding continues or if the limb is severed, apply a tourniquet. If bleeding stops check and treat for shock.

Use a tourniquet only as a last resort. Only use this method in order to save a life. Loss of limb is a high risk.

Shock

Depression of the body's vital functions causes shock. It is the bodies attempt to shut down systems so it can save energy and repair itself. Sometimes the body goes too far in its shut down. That's when shock happens. Shock is more likely to develop in severe injuries but may result from very minor injuries. Shock can kill even if the injuries alone would not have been fatal.

Signs and symptoms of shock include:

- Sweaty but cool (clammy) skin
- Loss of blood (bleeding)
- Paleness of skin
- Restlessness, nervousness
- Nausea and vomiting
- Thirst
- Faster than normal breathing
- Confusion
- Blotchy or bluish skin (around mouth and lips primarily)

First Aid For Shock

- * Maintain adequate breathing and heartbeat
- * Stop the bleeding.
- * Position the casualty
- * Move the casualty to cover if it is available and the situation permits.
- * Lay the casualty on their back, unless a sitting position will allow them to breathe easier.

Remember: “If face is red raise the head; if face is pale raise the tail.” Elevate the casualty’s feet higher than their heart on a stable object. Do not elevate feet if they have an abdominal wound, an unsplinted fracture of the leg, or a head injury.

- * Loosen tight clothing at the neck, waist or ankles, unless in a contaminated environment.
- * Keep the casualty from chilling or overheating. Maintain normal body temperature.
- * In cold weather lace a cover over and under them.
- * In hot weather place them in the shade.
- * Reassure the casualty and keep them calm.

First Aid For Specific Injuries

First Aid For Head Injuries

Head injuries may be open or closed. In open injuries there is an open head wound. In closed injuries there may be no visible wound since the skull is usually intact. If severe, either type of injury may be life threatening. Casualties may be confused and try to fight you. You may have to restrain the casualty to treat them.

The signs and symptoms of head injuries include staggering walk or dizziness, clear or bloody fluid leaking from the nose or ears, bleeding from the scalp or head area, deformity of the head, black eyes and facial bruises, confusion, vision problems (unequal pupils), current or recent loss of consciousness, Paralysis, headache, drowsiness, convulsions or twitches, loss of memory, breathing problems, slurred speech, nausea or vomiting

Always monitor head injuries for the development of any conditions, which may require basic lifesaving actions. For head injury consider the following actions:

- * Do not raise feet
- * Do not try to clean the wound
- * Do not remove impaled objects from the head
- * Do not put unnecessary pressure on the wound
- * Do not try to push brain matter back into the wound
- * Do not give casualty anything to eat or drink
- * Treat severe head injuries and unconscious casualties as a potential neck and back injury
- * Place a dressing over the injured area
- * Make a bulky dressing around any object protruding from the wound. Use the cleanest materials available for this dressing.
- * Maintain the casualties normal body temperature
- * Evaluate the casualty’s level of consciousness. Check every fifteen minutes and note changes. Ask- “What is your name?” “Where are you?” “What day is it?”
- * For a wound of the head do the following:
 - + Use a field dressing. Place it directly over the wound.
 - + Wrap the first tail around the head.
 - + Rap the second tail in the opposite direction covering the dressing.
 - + Tie a knot and secure the tails so the bandage does not slip off. Do not cover the eyes or ears.
 - + If there is no sign of shock, elevate the head slightly to help decrease pressure

Eye Injuries

Eyes are very sensitive to injuries such as scratches, bruises, cuts, and burns. Eye injuries are serious due to the possibility of blindness that may result. Symptoms of foreign objects in the eye include redness, a burning feeling, pain, headache, and overproduction of tears.

First Aid For Eye Injuries

- * Do not let the casualty rub their eyes
- * Do not use any sharp or hard instrument to remove the object
- * Do not use dry cotton around the eye
- * Wash your hands before examining the casualty's eye
- * Pull the lower lid down while the casualty looks up
- * Inspect the eyeball and the edge and the inside of the eyelid
- * Dampen the corner of a clean cloth or tissue paper and lift the object gently from the eye.
- * If you cannot find the object, it may be under the upper lid. While the casualty looks down, grasp the lashes of the upper lid. Gently pull the upper lid down over the lower lashes.

This may dislodge the object if it is on the upper lid. Tear action may also help remove the object.

If you cannot find the object or if the casualty is still having discomfort, flush the eye with clean water. Turn the casualty's head so that the water flushes away from the other eye. If you suspect the object is imbedded in the eye, apply a dry field dressing and seek medical aid.

Chest Wounds

Chest wounds are serious and may cause death quickly if not treated. An open chest wound caused by an object penetrating the chest wall may collapse the injured lung. The chest wall has been punctured if you hear a sucking sound. The casualty's life depends on how quick you make the cavity airtight.

The signs and symptoms of chest wounds may be first observed when the casualty may complain of pain in the chest or shoulder area. He may have difficulty in breathing. His chest may not rise normally when he breathes. The casualty may also cough up blood and have a rapid or a weak heartbeat. Breathing becomes difficult for the casualty because the wound is open.

First Aid For Chest Wounds

- * Check for both an entry and an exit wound and expose the wound site.
- * Make a seal over the wound with the plastic wrapper from the dressing or any clean material that will seal the wound. Place the seal directly over the wound as the casualty breathes out. Tape the seal on three sides to make a one way valve.
- * Apply the dressing directly over the seal.
- * Wrap the tails of the dressing around the body and tie in a knot over the wound. Pull the tails tight and tie as the casualty breathes out.
- * Position the casualty on the injured side.

Stomach (Abdominal) Wounds

A ruptured abdominal wall and damaged internal organs or large blood vessels create the most serious stomach wounds. You must act quickly to help save the casualty's life. Large wounds to the abdomen may expose the intestines or other parts. Support for these parts is given by the

muscles of the abdomen. When the muscles are injured, these parts may fall outside the body. Bleeding may be severe and death can occur rapidly.

First Aid For Abdominal Wounds

- * Do not clean, probe, or try to remove any foreign objects from the stomach.
- * Do not touch any exposed organs
- * Do not push organs back inside the abdomen.
- * If the bowels or intestines are visible, prevent any further exposure. Place the casualty on their back unless the other wounds prevent such action. Flex the casualty's knees to relax the abdominal muscles and any internal pressure.
- * If the dressing wrapper is large enough to extend well beyond the protruding bowel, use it to help cover the wound. Place the inside (sterile side) of the dressing wrapper directly over the wound with a field dressing on top.
- * Tie the legs together with a strap in a figure eight above the casualty's knees if other injuries permit.
- * When applying the dressing, do not put pressure on the wound or any exposed internal parts. This pressure could cause further problems such as vomiting, ruptured intestines, etc. Tie the dressing tails loosely at the casualty's side, not directly over the wound. Moisten the dressing with clean water only and keep it moist.
- * Pick up any organs that may be on the ground with a clean dressing or the cleanest available material. Place the organs on top of the casualty's stomach; if possible keep them moist.

Burns

Burns are serious injuries. Shock, dehydration, and infection often accompany burns. Prompt action helps reduce possible further injury and illness. Medical personnel should evaluate all burns after first aid is administered. Before administering first aid for burn injuries you must:

- * Recognize the type of burn: Thermal, Electrical, Chemical
- * Remove the casualty from the source of the burn
- * Thermal: smother the fire
- * Electrical: Secure the power and remove the casualty from the source using a nonconductive material such as a dry rope, sheet, blanket, or wooden pole. Do not come into direct contact with the casualty until he is removed from the source.
- * Chemical: Remove liquids by flushing with as much water as possible. Remove dry chemicals by brushing off loose particles first then flush completely with water.
- * Evaluate the casualty for conditions requiring basic life saving measures.

First Aid For Burns

Treat the burns. Expose the burn and apply a field dressing or the cleanest material available. If the casualty is conscious and not nauseated, give him sips of water. If possible mix one teaspoon salt to one quart of water give the casualty about 4 ounces (one half cup) in 15 minutes.

- * Do not remove clothing stuck to the burn.
- * Do not break any blisters
- * Do not cut away or lift clothing in a contaminated environment
- * Do not decontaminate the skin where blisters have formed
- * Do not apply grease or ointments to burns.

For thermal burns, cool water is the best treatment for reddened (first-degree burn) or slightly blistered skin (second-degree burn). For severe blisters (second-degree burn), cover with the cleanest material available and wet dressing with cold water. When the skin is charred black or white (third degree burn), cover with a sterile bandage. Third degree burns usually destroy nerves so the casualty may not feel pain.

For electrical burns:

- * Check for both an entry and an exit burn.
- * Treat as a thermal burn.
- * Watch the casualty for signs of needing CPR or rescue breathing.

For chemical burns:

- * Flush away liquids with water.
- * Brush away dry chemical particles first. Remove as much chemical as possible, then flush with water
- * Monitor for shock and treat if necessary. Seek medical help ASAP.

Fractures

There are two types of fracture: Closed fracture: A break in the bone without a break in the overlying skin. Open Fracture: A break in the bone as well as the overlying skin. Signs and symptoms of fracture injuries include: deformity, pain, tenderness, swelling, bleeding, protruding bone, inability to move injured part, discolored skin at the site of the injury.

First Aid For Fractures

Fractures must be splinted or immobilized to prevent razor sharp edges of the bone from moving through and cutting tissue, muscle, and blood vessels. This helps reduce the pain and control shock. It also prevents closed fractures from becoming open fractures. Apply a field dressing to open fractures before splinting.

Splints may be improvised from boards, poles, sticks, rolled newspapers, cardboard and anything that is rigid. If nothing is available tie the fractured area to an uninjured body part such as the casualties other leg or chest. Padding may be improvised from jackets, blankets, and even leafy plants.

Slings may be used to support an injured arm in a bandage suspended from the casualty's neck. Slings may be improvised by using the tail of a shirt or coat or pieces of clothing or blankets. A triangular bandage is perfect for a sling.

Back and Neck Injuries

It is very difficult to tell if a casualty has a back or neck injury. If the casualty can not move his arms or legs or does not have feeling, you can be reasonably sure that there is a back or neck injury, which should be treated as a fracture. CAUTION: If the back or neck is fractured, bending it can cause sharp bone fragments to bruise or cut the spinal cord and result in permanent paralysis. Move the casualty only if other dangerous conditions exist.

Snake and Insect Bites and Stings

Snakebites, insect bites, and stings can cause intense pain and swelling if not treated correctly, they can cause serious injury or death.

First Aid For Snakebite

- * Get the casualty away from the snake.
- * Remove all rings and bracelets from the affected extremity.
- * Reassure the casualty and keep him quiet, avoid any activity.
- * If an ACE elastic wrap is available wrap it firmly around the site of the bite.
- * Immobilize the affected area at or below heart level.
- * Seek medical help ASAP

First Aid For Brown Recluse or Black Widow Spider Bites

- * Keep the casualty quiet.
- * Wash the area.
- * Apply Ice or freeze packs if available.
- * Seek medical Aid ASAP.

First Aid For Bee Stings

If the stinger is present, remove it by scraping it with a knife or fingernail. Do not squeeze the venom sack on the stinger; more venom may be injected. Wash the area. 3. Apply Ice or freeze pack. 4. If allergic symptoms like shock appear, be prepared to perform basic life support measures and seek medical help ASAP.

ANDREWS AREA UPDATE

NCCM staff are looking into several reports of events related to western North Carolina, including the situation in Andrews. Several reports still being investigated and are too speculative at this time to be discussed with any degree of confidence. However, some interesting points and speculation may be beneficial as a way of maintaining continuity to this ongoing situation.

The NCCM Public Affairs Officer has recently been interviewed by a prominent TV news team seeking input for a story about the continued MJTF presence in Andrews. In particular, they were examining the tremendous expenditures involved with maintaining a large task force and questioning their continued justification given a total absence of tangible result. Pretty convenient, the recent Asheville incident, wouldn't you say?

Pending political intervention, the 210th and 211th National Guard Military Police companies based in Clyde, NC were anticipating deactivation. Members have recently been informed that these companies have been redesignated to the role of “Prison Guard” and have received

instructional materials relative to this activity including those outlining procedures for civilian detainment. As of this writing we understand that neither company has received written orders or an official MOS designation. Further information and confirmation will be provided as available.

A recent McAlvany Intelligence Advisor newsletter states that there is growing evidence of high priority preparations for marshall law in the US. We concur. The events in Andrews and elsewhere provide ample cause for speculation in this regard. Certainly, the “captive” population has provided a real world laboratory for assessing current tolerance levels for political manipulation. BOOK REVIEW:

The Coming Collision: Global Law vs. U.S. Liberties [ISBN: 1-56384-157-6]

The Coming Collision written by James L. Hirsen, Ph.D. and published by Huntington House Publishers in 1999 is quite a remarkable book. It is a book about liberty, the Constitution, and the globalist agenda to subvert them through international treaty. It's a simple book, and relatively inexpensive. It contains only 200 pages, but well researched and easy to read. As an internationally recognized attorney, the author speaks with a certain knowledge, clarity and in a straightforward style that allows those less familiar with the issues to quickly grasp the facts, and the ominous implications of encroaching globalism.

America, Hirsen observes, is drowning in a "sea of rules and red tape". In large part he explains, this is because of a growing body of international agreements ("soft law") and treaties which most Americans believe are intended to apply to relationships between nations, but which are actually being used to intrude and infringe upon our most fundamental rights and to affect our lives to the smallest detail.

From talk radio and newsletters many of us are aware of the structured decline of America. Sometimes we need something more than a passing summary of why and how things have gone so un-American, but something less than a legal treatise only a dedicated scholar would understand. This is it.

The author characterizes the globalist community as an "insidious bureaucracy" which is creating a serious threat to family integrity, property rights, religious and other freedoms. He explains how treaties are being used to unconstitutionally support international population control, separation of church and state, and unilateral disarmament among other usurpations. Hirsen uses history to illustrate the intent of our founding fathers and briefly, but succinctly explains how the courts and the political system have been used to corrupt constitutional intent. Hirsen explains:

"The Constitution requires that treaties must be approved by a two-thirds vote of the Senate in order to be enforceable as American law. In recent years, this constitutional provision has been repeatedly ignored. The evasion of proper procedural requirements has had enormous consequences on the functioning of our government and serious effects on the discourse with the American people. The saga of manipulating events and averting the Constitution involves sophisticated public relation campaigns, and oftentimes outright duplicity, revealing the ugly underbelly of politics." Hirsen, p. 114.

Hirsen's review is relatively brief, but it does not overlook many international treaty issues. He discusses NAFTA and GATT, the political ramifications of radical feminism and the impacts of a variety of assaults on our liberties from paganism to population control. He reviews the origin of environmentalism and describes how junk science is used to manipulate populations, usurp private property rights, and influence political aggrandizement to meet globalist agendas through such programs as the World Heritage Program, the Biodiversity Treaty and others.

In his chapter, Trading Away The Constitution, Hirsen examines the origins and purpose of legislation aimed at achieving total US disarmament and the goals of the United Nations toward global military hegemony. He exposes the sham of UN peacekeeping operations and the goal of appropriating the US military establishment to support the worldwide global aspirations of the UN.

In discussing means to fight this conflict, which he describes as a battle between "good and evil", Hirsen calls upon Americans to be vocal and active in political and social institutions, to help rejuvenate our culture through letter writing, taking part in legislative processes and engaging in other forms of social activism to educate and sway public opinion and influence positive legislative

action. In calling upon Americans to answer the call to preserve the republic the author is restrained in his optimism and anticipates a difficult course.

“Yet those who understand the original intent of the founding fathers also realize the true source of our freedoms. The freedoms to be born, to live, to raise and educate our children, to worship, and to own private property are sacred rights. Aleksandr Solzhenitsyn, who stared into the face of totalitarianism in the Soviet Union, spoke of the loss of freedoms in the Western world when he said, “Tragically, however, the free west will only believe it when it is no longer free. To quote a Russian proverb, ‘When it happens you will know it is true, but then it is too late.’” Hirsens, p. 166.

If you have been looking for a reference that explains how many international agreements and treaties are actively being used to control our lives and property, or if you simply need facts which can be used to show others how these acts are being used to destroy a free America, this should be an excellent reference for your library.

Gun Show Arrests:

Undercover agents charged eleven men with selling or buying pistols without a permit at the C&E gun show held at the Metrolina Expo Center in Charlotte, NC on February 13th. As a result of this success, undercover agents will now attend all gun shows in Mecklenburg County to keep an eye out for “no paperwork” gun sales. Sheriff Jim Pendergraph said “they will be watching the parking lots and grounds for these illegal sales”. “I believe law-abiding citizens have the right to own a gun,” Pendergraph said, “but you have to get a permit. The whole point of the law is to protect people from criminals.”

Authorities confiscated ten handguns, three pocket knives, and \$1,100 in cash. “We will be present at every gun show in the future, and we will be actively enforcing the law,” Pendergraph said. Purchasing a pistol without a permit or selling a pistol without a permit is a misdemeanor, punishable by up to 60 days in jail and a \$1,000 fine.

Military Retirement Funds:

Confidence. That’s what holds the economy together in the absence of real money. Only confidence can give value to fictional money. Confidence inspires sustainability, and behind confidence is the character of those in whom that trust resides.

That brings us to Clinton’s promise of an increase in pay and improved retirement package to service men and women. The End Of The Rope: Australian Update

Some of the more idealistic members of the gun culture tend to grasp at any compromise with those seeking total control of firearms regardless of how many times events demonstrate the futility of compromise. The goal of the would-be controllers is nothing less than total disarmament and subjugation. Case in point is illustrated in an article from the February, 1999 issue of *Small Arms Review* (Vol. 2, No. 5) where we learn of the magnanimity of the South Australian police. That is, the amnesty period for those persons owning body armor (bullet "proof" vests) may be extended to February, 2000. At that time they must be surrendered or those found in possession face a two year jail term or \$8000 fine.

Similarly, legislation is pending in South Australia which would provide a short amnesty period for persons possessing certain knives and related martial weapons. Those owning "flick" knives, daggers, knuckle knives, and throwing stars among other types of weapons face up to two years in jail and \$10,000 in fines if found in one's possession after the proposed amnesty period. Clearly, South Australia is quickly becoming a "safe" and totally disarmed society.

Will someone in the NRA please call and reassure us it won't happen here?

Y2K Meeting Fallout:

A few of our compatriots report attending various Y2K seminars and discussion groups around the state. They have told us that many concerned citizens from a wide variety of backgrounds are attending these meetings. Together they are working to understand the potential ramifications of Y2K and approach the issue of preparedness from a variety of perspectives. Of concern to our reporters is that all too many of the participants focus of security, energy resources, financial matters, and other issues and give relatively little attention to food and water supplies.

We can't possibly know what is "right" for everyone. Various knowledgeable individuals have recommended the purchase of from two weeks to seven years family food storage reserves. Given the potential for economic disruption, doing nothing is also an extreme.

Most people allocate hundreds if not thousands of dollars each year on insurance from which there is seldom an expectation of return. A properly managed food reserve is the only type insurance that pays in full regardless of whether a crisis occurs. In the event of a crisis, it won't

matter what your neighbors think, and you won't get a second chance. Boot leather and FRN's make pretty poor fare even if well seasoned with wild onions.

Instant Check System Update:

The Federal Bureau of Investigation, Department of Justice has published a proposed rule in the Federal Register which announces an amendment to the Brady Bill National Instant Criminal Background Check System (NCIS). The revision appears to be an attempt to allay citizens concerns about a permanent national firearms registry by stipulating that the FBI will maintain records for only 90 days instead of the initially proposed 18 month period. Among the purposes of this amendment is to "safeguard the security and privacy of personal information in the system".

We observe that the proposal looks great from a political perspective. Cynics will recall that these are the same loyal corporate employees who were instrumental in the FBI lab scandal and attempted cover-up of the Waco Massacre among other notable deceptions. Incurable optimists can celebrate the illusion of a political "victory" by reading Volume 64, No. 41 of the Federal Register for Wednesday, March 3, 1999, p. 10262 ff.

Beleived civil government was ordained and established by God, but that the civil government so established had only limited authority. That is, limited to enforcement of law insorfar Constitution envisioned federal ogvernment with only powers delegated to it by the people, through the constitution (powers derived form consent of the govermed). Further that even the limited authority granted to that government was given only conditionally. The people themselves, the grantors, reserved the right to teminate their contract if those to whom the authirity was delegaed violated the laws of God and nauttre by suppressing the basic liberties of the people.

To police we might observe that as representatives of the magistrates must enforce laws lawfully above all nothing contridicts God’s laws or will face judgement for it.

slayers, for whoeramongers, for them that define themselves with mankind, for menseaalers, forliars, for the perjured persons, and if thee be any other thing that is contrary to sound doctrine...”

Futher, the Declaration observes the right, even the duty, to resist unlawful authority. This then is the antithesis of Romans 13, which mandates obedience to lawful government and conversely by defining the responsibility of lawful government mandates that Christians must resist unlawful government when it runs contrary to God’s law.

God charged use of sword for proper lawful enforcement of laws, proper tool of government. Live by sword shall die by sword meant to apply to those who lived by plunder and violence literally unlawful measures. (Like mercenaries, Hessians?) Person defending self is not livign by sword but use of sword in lawful defense.

Premise of many Christians is that since all authority is from God and must be obeyed must first understand how Bible defines authority. Means that authority is borne of or derived from God

Founders believed there was no escape from the tyranny before them. They petitioned time after time for redress of grievances to the king only to be ignored or spurned.

Gods authority protects the life of the righteous and those who do good works.

Fearful men, seedin gto avoid responsibility tendency tocling to intrepertations that will require nothing of them .

Luke 11:46..52 “Woe to you also, ye lawyers for ye lade men with burdens grievous to be borne, and ye yourselves touch not the burdens with one of your fingers.” “Woe unt o you, lawyers! for ye have taken away the key of knowledge: ye entered not in yourselves, and them that were entering in ye hindered.”

Those who devise evil by law or to condemn righteous people and activities are an abomination to God.

Commandment violated thou shalt not steal.

Puritans believed that power had a corrupting influence and could be used to oppress others. Therefore

Thou shall not steal, conversely conveyed biblical right to private property
Thou shall not murder, with other scripture, dictated that all men have a right to life

Constitution contains no specific reference to God, Founders fearful of wording which would mandate a state church and the need to avoid religious references which could have caused division and strife between varying protestant churches

According to Eidsmoe (1987) the Declaration is “a statement of the basic American values or principles: equality, God-given rights. The Constitution is the means by which these rights are to be secured...”

Declaration of Independence refers to “Laws of Nature and Nature’s God.”, and observes that “All men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among those are Life, Liberty and the pursuit of Happiness.” This recognition reflects in the universal belief of that time that man was subject to a higher [God’s] law and that civil government and the laws implemented by that government should conform to that higher law.

“Now the Lord is that Spirit: and where the Spirit of the Lord is, there is liberty”. 2 Cor. 3:17

Eidsmoe reflects that God’s commandment “Thou shall not murder” (Exodus 20:13) confers a right to life; the admonition not to kidnap or enslave others confers a right to liberty (Deuteronomy 24:7) and the commandment “Thou shalt not steal (Exodus 20:15) establishes a right to property.

Our constitutional government was established in part to secure these rights, and to “Secure the Blessings of Liberty to ourselves and our Posterity.”

IN adopting the Constitution the Founders recognized that these and other enumerated and non-enumerated rights are not granted by Government, nor can Government deprive their citizens of them. More specifically it is the primary duty and responsibility of government to secure these “unalienable” rights. God’s established government was intended to be one of integrity, honesty, honest weights and measures, is this what we have today?

Having established the lawful authority and responsibility of government consistent with biblical laws, the Founders clearly defined the limits to lawful government to which all citizens must be obedient. It is a government of laws not of men, a higher authority.

Taking Things For Granted

They included specific natural or "Biblical" rights retained by the people over which the federal government would have absolutely no authority to regulate. Liberties, including the rights of property, assembly, security, assembly and arms, were considered by the Founders of the Republic the gift of God. and recognized by the Constitution. It is the PRIMAERY DUTY of government to ensure that these freedoms are never compromised.

The general public does not simply lack of understanding of the Constitution in general, but most importantly its central principle, i.e., limited government. Most consider government to limitations of government to consist of trimming bureaucratic staffs, miniscule reductions in the number of regulations, limiting porkbarrel projects, or whatever promises and constraints government may pledge to place limits on legalized thievery.

For anyone with the ability to read, the case is clear: undefined powers and authorities belong to the States or the people themselves. The presumptive power grab is a clear usurpation of states rights and a direct usurpation of the 10th Amendment.
